

Bike Routes... (Streets with Shared Lane Markings)

A Shared Lane Marking or “sharrow” alerts both bicyclists and motorists that sharing the same space on the road is a necessity. These symbols are located on streets that are too narrow for bicycle lanes, or at intersections where bicycle lanes end and the cyclist is encouraged to scan, signal and move to the center of the lane.
