

## SUMMARIZATION OF SWAT VIDEO KINLOCH CT

Swat copy of video is approximately 00:04:23 in length. Video begins dark and out of focus but shows officers lining up to make entry.

00:20 Officers are lined up and open storm door.

00:26 Officers knock on door and announce themselves. A bark is heard.

00:34 Door is found to be unlocked and opened slightly by officers.

00:36 Loud noise heard (believed to be Officer Horrell breaching back gate)

00:37 First shot fired, dog heard whimpering.

00:39 Door is opened further. (Loud noise heard) Officers make entry, continue to announce themselves and a dog can be heard barking.

00:44 Second shot heard and sounds of dog whimpering/yelping/barking. Some officers go to the left and some officers go to the right. Video scans back and forth across living area.

00:52 Officers make contact with male subject in hallway to the right.

00:58-00:59 Three consecutive shots heard.

01:04 Male subject seen prone on the floor in hallway. Officers have him at gunpoint advising they "need one, need one".

01:12: Other officers move into the hallway.

01:13 Female and male child appear from end of hallway and directed to "move past him".

01:16 Officer says to female and child, "Come on guys, you're fine, you're fine".

01:20 Female and child move to the foyer area.

01:22 Video pans back to male subject lying prone in hallway.

01:23 An officer approaches the male subject and he tells him not to move. As the officer reaches the subject, he tells him, "Put your hands behind your back, do it now!". Subject puts his hands on top of his head. Officer again tells subject, "Behind your back!", and kicks the subject's right hand/arm, attempting to move his arm(s) behind his back. The subject then appears to comply with the officer's direction.

01:31 Video gets dark but can make out an officer standing over the male subject in hallway

01:33 Can hear officers in background continuing to announce themselves throughout the house. One officer states, "We have another injured one."

01:39 Male subject asks, "An injured one what?" and rolls slightly to his side. He is directed by the officer, "Do not move".

01:49 Male subject asks, "What is happening?" Officer tells him, "Search warrant, narcotics search warrant, don't move."

01:55 Sounds of handcuffs being applied.

01:57 Video pans to the left through living area and to other officers in a room off to the left.

02:02 Video pans back to right to officers in hallway with male subject.

02:05 Male subject says, "Please don't hurt my dogs, they're nice dogs".

02:07 Video shows what appears to be a dog pass by (right to left) at the end of the hallway and an officer says "Come here".

02:11 Officer says, "Leave the dog alone, we're good, let's get him secured".

02:13 Officer advises, "He's in handcuffs."

02:14 Shows an officer coming forward out of the hallway and checking a room to the right (his left).

02:15 Can hear officer giving male subject commands, "Up to your knees, stand up."

02:17 The officer who came forward out of the hallway takes up a position to the left (his right) as another officer walks male subject out of the hallway.

02:21 Video pans to the left through living room area, shows furniture and TV, which is turned on.

In background you can hear officers talking with male subject asking his name. Also another officer advising, "I want a secondary."

02:27 Video pans left and shows female and child sitting in foyer with one officer standing with them. Officer Dodd seen coming in the front door into the foyer area. It also shows two officers with male subject against the living room wall.

02:28 Officers are asking male subject his name and he says he wants a lawyer. The officers are conducting a search of the male subject who has advised his name is John.

02:44 Shows officers walking through house. Male subject asks, "What the fuck did I do?"

02:50 Video is out of focus and is panning across the areas of the house.

02:52 Video pans to kitchen area. Male subject can be heard asking if officers had shot his dog.

02:57 The video pans across the house and a loud commotion can be heard with male subject yelling about his dog being shot and female subject saying "Oh my god". You can hear what sounds like the whimpering of a dog.

03:00 Shows two officers standing with male subject against wall.

03:09 Officer advises, "Cathy, let's get her out to (inaudible, possibly " to 04") or sit her in the van".

03:15 Video is very dark but still showing officers with male subject up against the wall.

03:17 Officer requests that 803 respond to 1501 Kinloch.

03:22 Officer asks, "Somebody got a card? Let's get him Mirandized."

03:27 Officer says, "Let's get some lights on in here".

03:30 Lights come on.

03:31 Male subject continues to ask officers why they shot his dog.

03:47 Males subject read his Miranda rights.

04:05 Male subject refuses to state whether he understands his rights or not. He is asked again if he understands and he continues to refuse to answer and turns his face away from the officer. Officers advise him they will take that as a yes and advise him he is on audio tape. Male says, "That's fine."

04:15 Officers escort male subject toward the front door.

04:19 Video pans to corner of living room and stops on a side table
